BACKGROUND/HISTORY:

Presenter: Craig McCroskey, United Way

The United Way of Henry County and Martinsville, in partnership with the City of Martinsville, is pursuing a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) planning application to address growing challenges related to homelessness, substance use, and access to support services. In recent years, both Martinsville and Henry County have seen sharp increases in need, while existing services remain fragmented and difficult to navigate. At the same time, multiple local organizations are beginning to explore day center models, reinforcing the importance of a coordinated approach. This planning effort will evaluate current resources, identify gaps, and consider solutions ranging from improved service coordination to the potential establishment of a community day support center.

The CDBG Planning Grant provides up to \$75,000 to support community assessments, planning, and engagement around local service needs. The United Way and its partners will lead this process by convening a project team, hosting public meetings, and developing a sustainable strategy for service delivery. While the project may ultimately support the creation of a day center, the broader goal is to design a coordinated system of health and social supports for low- and moderate-income households, particularly those experiencing homelessness and substance use disorders. Completion of this planning phase will position the community to apply for a future project grant to put the plan into action.

BACKGROUND/HISTORY:

Presenters: Kendall Topping, Jessica Huang-Green Infrastructure Center (partnership with the Tree Board)

Martinsville's Community Forest Revitalization Program, launched in June 2024 with the Green Infrastructure Center, aims to increase the city's tree canopy from 55% to 56% over the next decade while improving tree quality, safety, and maintenance. Supported by federal and state funding, the program addresses heat reduction, stormwater management, economic vitality, and public health benefits, with extreme heat days projected to rise sharply by 2070. The forthcoming Strategic Tree Canopy Plan will guide planting in priority areas, control invasive species, expand public education, and build city capacity for urban forest management. Since its launch, the program has hosted workshops, a 60-tree giveaway, and community events that gathered nearly 100 public comments, positioning Martinsville to secure grant funding and create a healthier, cooler, and more resilient community.

No formal action is requested at this time. This presentation is intended to inform Council on the progress of the Community Forest Revitalization Program, share findings from the tree canopy analysis, and outline next steps for the Strategic Tree Canopy Plan. Council's role is to receive the update, provide feedback or questions as desired, and remain informed ahead of future decisions related to urban forestry initiatives, funding opportunities, or policy adoption stemming from the plan's recommendations.

BACKGROUND/HISTORY:

As part of the FY2025-26 budget process, the transfer for the debt service for the General Fund and the Water & Sewer Fund were approved within the operating budget, but the transfer from each of those respective funds to the corresponding CIP Funds and the actual debt payments were not. This action is to ensure the appropriation of the transfers and payment for debt service are properly annotated within the general ledger. Also, during the FY2025-26 budget development process the City of Martinsville had not received the final authorized street payment amount from the Commonwealth of Virginia. Since the final amount had not been received, the City of Martinsville budgeted for the same amount (\$4,442,000) that was utilized for FY2024-25 with the intent of bringing forth any additional amount for City Council to appropriate once the final amount was provided. The final amount approved was \$4,765,175.14. The intention is to appropriate the difference which is \$323,175.14.

First Reading -- August 12, 2025

Second Reading -- August 26, 2025

POLICY EXPLANATION:

In accordance with § 15.2-2506 and 15.2-2507 of the Code of Virginia, only the governing body may authorize budget appropriations. Any locality may amend its budget to adjust the aggregate amount to be appropriated during the current fiscal year as shown in the currently adopted budget as prescribed by § 15.2-2504. However, any such amendment which exceeds one percent of the total expenditures shown in the currently adopted budget must be accomplished by publishing notice of a meeting and a public hearing in accordance with § 15.2-1427.

Council approval is required to appropriate funds for this purchase.

FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE:

There is no fiscal impact as the expenses from the General Fund and the Water & Sewer Fund

are already appropriated. This action is to appropriate the actual payments within the respective CIP Funds and the additional Streets Funds monies.

In accordance with Section 33.2-319 of the Code of Virginia, the payment rates per lane mile for street payments have been approved by the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) for Fiscal Year 2026. In addition, Codes of Virginia 46.2-1140.1, 46.2-1143, 46.2-1148 and 46.2-1149 authorize the CTB to distribute overweight permit fee revenue based on lane mileage to localities eligible for maintenance payments. Payments will be made quarterly each year by the 30th of September, December, March and June by Electronic Data Interface (EDI).

I am writing on behalf of Martinsville Fire & EMS to formally request grant match funding for or **\$60,000** to acquire two new LifePak 35 cardiac monitors. This request is crucial as we approach the expiration of two existing monitors this December. Given their five—to eight-year life cycle, these particular monitors will soon be ineligible for calibration or repair. While the American Heart Association recommends replacement after five years, our current service provider can maintain them up to eight years. At this time, we have the two with a manufacturer date of 2013, one with 2019, and two with 2023. All are currently in service.

Importance of LifePak Monitors

The **LifePak monitors** are indispensable in our mission to provide advanced healthcare services. These devices are equipped to:

- Measure blood pressure and oxygen saturation levels

BACKGROUND/HISTORY:

To facilitate the Indian Trail Transformer project, the City seeks to declare its intention to reimburse itself from the proceeds of one or more future tax-exempt financings. This resolution satisfies IRS reimbursement requirements and aligns with Treasury regulations (Treas. Reg. § 1.150-2) by establishing:

- A formal declaration of official intent,
- A maximum not-to-exceed principal amount (\$3,000,000),
- A retroactive reimbursement window (up to 60 days prior to adoption and forward),

Timing parameters for reimbursement allocations (within 18 months of expenditure or project service, but in no event more than 3 years), with noted exceptions for preliminary expenditures, issuance costs, small issuers, and long-term construction projects.

POLICY EXPLANATION:

§ 15.2-2636. Ordinance or resolution to provide for issue of bonds.

Except as otherwise provided in this section, whenever any municipality proposes to borrow money and issue its bonds under the provisions of Article VII, Section 10(a), of the Constitution of Virginia and this chapter, the governing body shall adopt an ordinance or resolution, stating the maximum principal amount of the bonds to be issued and in brief and general terms the purpose or purposes for which the proceeds of the bonds are to be used.

FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE:

There is no immediate effect on the City's General Fund. The resolution simply authorizes a mechanism for internal reimbursement and does not authorize new spending or borrowing at this time.

ACTION REQUESTED/ALTERNATIVES

It is recommended that the Council adopt this resolution, which enables the City to reimburse eligible capital expenditures using tax-exempt bond proceeds once the financing is secured.

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**RESOLUTION OF CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARTINSVILLE,

WHEREAS, the City of Martinsville, Virginia (**the “City”**) is a body politic and corporate organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia; and

WHEREAS, the City has paid beginning no earlier than 60 days prior to the date of adoption of this resolution, and will pay, on and after the date hereof, certain expenditures (**“Expenditures”**) for the design, acquisition and equipping of a City capital improvement project , further described on Exhibit A attached hereto (**the “Project”**); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City (**the “Council”**) has determined that those moneys previously advanced no earlier than 60 days prior to the date of adoption of this resolution and to be advanced on and after the date hereof to pay the Expenditures are available only for a temporary period and it is necessary to reimburse the City for the Expenditures from the proceeds of one or more issues of a tax-exempt financing (**the “Financing”**).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARTINSVILLE, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. The Council hereby declares the City’s intent to reimburse the City with the proceeds of the Financing for the Expenditures with respect to the Project made on and after 60 days prior to the date of adoption of this resolution. The City reasonably expects on the date hereof that it will reimburse the Expenditures with the proceeds of the Financing.

Section 2. Each Expenditure was and will be either (a) of a type properly chargeable to capital account under general federal income tax principles (determined in each case as of the date of the Expenditures), (b) a cost of issuance with respect to the Financing, (c) a nonrecurring item that is not customarily payable from current revenues, or (d) a grant to a party that is not related to or an agent of the City so long as such grant does not impose any obligation or condition (directly or indirectly) to repay any amount to or for the benefit of the City.

Section 3. The maximum principal amount of the Financing expected to be issued for the Project is \$3,000,000.

Section 4. The City will make a reimbursement allocation, which is a written allocation by the City that evidences the City’s use of proceeds of the Financing to reimburse an Expenditure, no later than 18 months after the later of the date on which the Expenditure is paid or the Project is placed in service or abandoned, but in no event more than three years after the date on which the Expenditure is paid. The City recognizes that exceptions are available for

certain “preliminary expenditures,” costs of issuance, certain de minimis amounts, expenditures by “small issuers” (based on the year of issuance and not the year of expenditure) and expenditures for construction projects of at least 5 years.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

The City has been part of nationwide lawsuits against companies and individuals that contributed to the opioid crisis. Recently, two new settlements have been announced:

- Sackler Family Settlement – about \$6.5 billion
- Number of Different Manufacturers Settlement (listed in Resolution) – about \$720 million

If the City chooses to participate, it will receive a share of these settlement funds. These dollars can only be used for efforts to fight the opioid epidemic, such as treatment, prevention, recovery services, and related community needs.

By participating, the City gives up its right to sue the Sacklers and these manufacturers separately in the future, but in return **becomes eligible for its share of the settlement money.**

- Number of Different Manufacturers Settlement – about \$720 million

If the City chooses to participate, it will receive a share of these settlement funds. These dollars can only be used for efforts to fight the opioid epidemic, such as treatment, prevention, recovery services, and related community needs.

By participating, the City gives up its right to sue the Sacklers and these manufacturers separately in the future, but in return **becomes eligible for its share of the settlement money.**
