 - **Moss/Market St:** Sign damaged twice by cars. VDOT will not replace, city will have to if they want the reflective, collapsible signs.

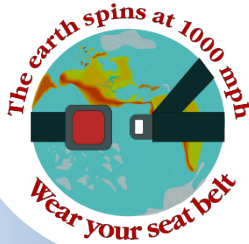
