- b. **2.2-3711 (A8)** Consultation with legal counsel employed or retained by a public body regarding specific legal matters requiring the provision of legal advice by such counsel. With regard to Virginia's State and Local Government Conflicts of Interests Act and Attorney-Client Privilege.
